Eligibility:

- Students aged 10–18 years from schools, NGOs, Organisations or Groups



Qualifying Criteria:

- Submit concept note (150–250 words) outlining the environmental theme and key messages
- Submit behind-the-scenes video (1–2 minutes) showing rehearsal and creative process

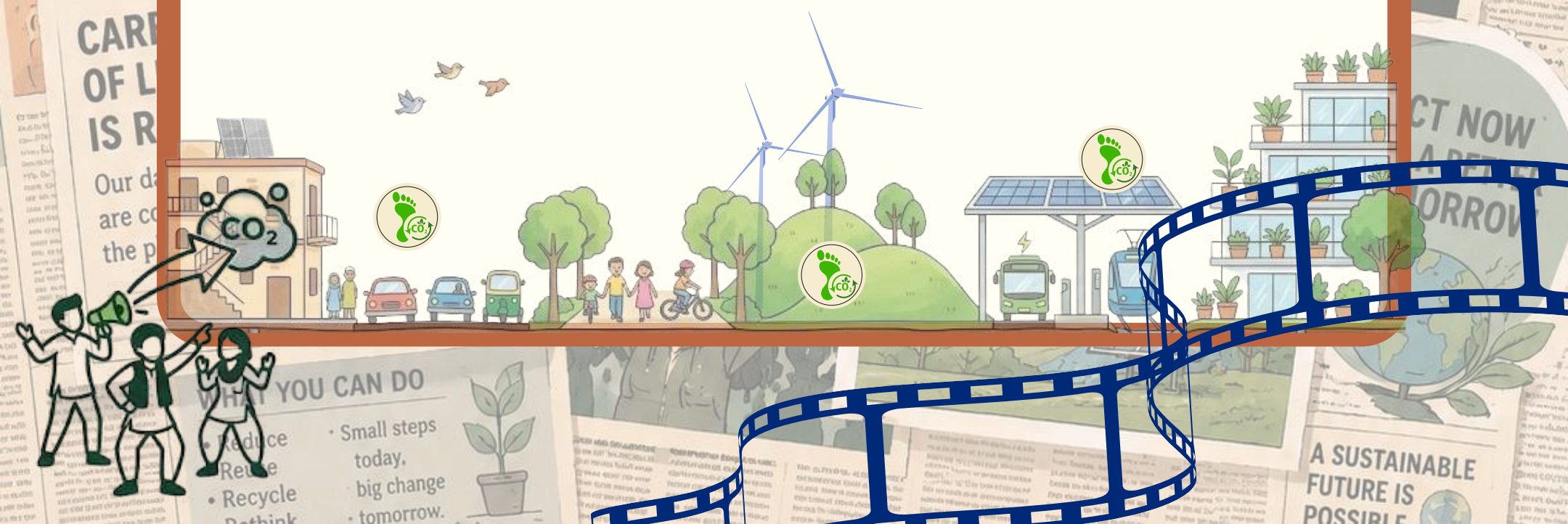


Guidelines:

- Group of 7 to 10 participants
- Hindi, English, or both languages are welcome
- Background music allowed without vocals
- Final performance: maximum 8 minutes
- Use own costumes and props (sustainability-themed)
- Avoid stereotypes; ensure inclusive and respectful representation

Eligibility:

- Students aged 10–18 years from schools, NGOs, Organisations or Groups



Qualifying Criteria:

- Submit concept note (150–250 words) explaining the sustainability narrative and design choices
- Submit behind-the-scenes video (1–2 minutes) of outfit creation and rehearsal



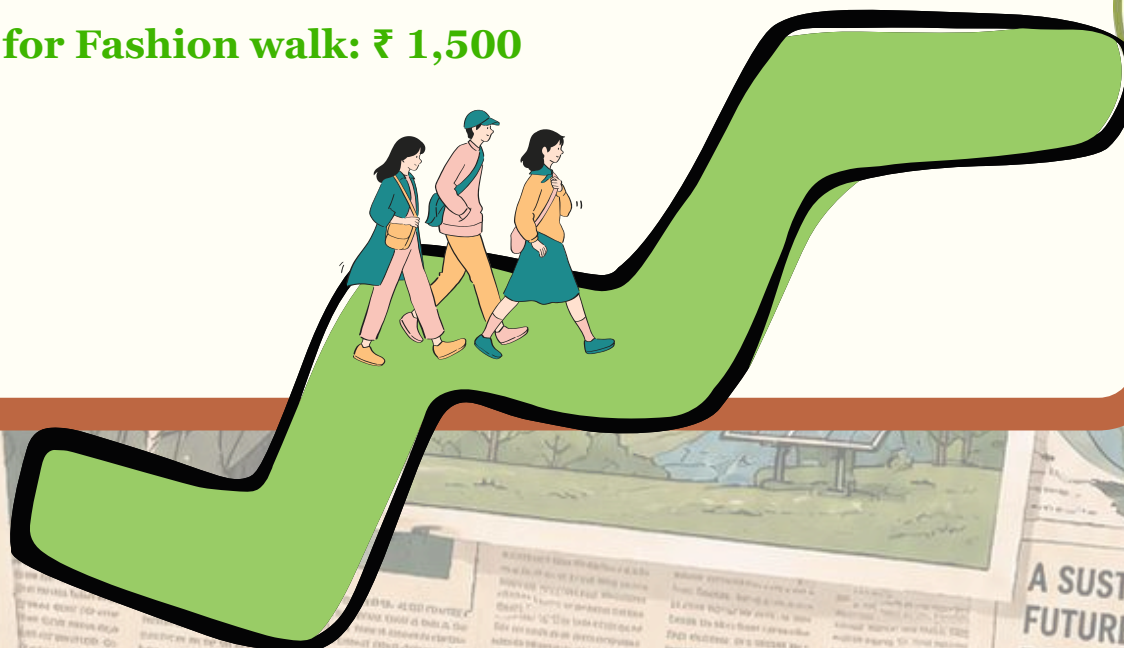
Guidelines:

- Group of 7 to 10 participants
- All costumes made from eco-friendly materials: upcycled fabrics, natural fibres (jute, cotton, hemp, bamboo, etc.), biodegradable elements, or creative waste materials
- No synthetic or newly purchased fashion items are allowed
- Final performance: maximum 8 minutes
- Performance should be age-appropriate and culturally sensitive
- 1-minute pre-recorded introduction explaining the concept (audio submission required)
- Background music allowed; share audio 2 weeks before event

EXHIBITION: CTRL + ALT + DECARB

Reimagine a low-carbon future through innovative exhibits. Showcase climate solutions, sustainable technologies, and responsible practices that contribute to decarbonization. Demonstrate how innovation can drive meaningful change and accelerate the transition towards a Net Zero future.



Eligibility:

- Students aged 10–18 years from schools, NGOs, Organisations or Groups



Qualifying Criteria:

- Submit concept note (150–250 words) describing the model concept and real-world impact
- Submit behind-the-scenes video (1–2 minutes) showing model construction



Guidelines:

- Individual or group up to 10 participants
- Model dimensions: maximum 2 feet × 2 feet
- Include a brief written explanation (250–500 words) on how the model addresses carbon reduction

Eligibility:

- Students aged 10–18 years from schools, NGOs, Organisations or Groups



Qualifying Criteria:

- Submit concept note (150–250 words) describing the creative act, its underlying theme, objectives & message being communicated through the performance.
- Submit short video showcasing the preparation and development of the performance, highlighting the creative process, planning, rehearsals and execution (1–2 minutes).



Guidelines:

- Individual or group up to 10 participants
- Performance must centre on environmental or sustainability themes
- Duration: maximum 5 minutes
- Use own props, costumes, and equipment
- 1-minute pre-recorded intro explaining the concept (audio submission required)
- Background music allowed; share audio 2 weeks before event
- Performance must be age-appropriate & culturally sensitive
- Safety first: Please ensure no hazardous materials or risky performances are conducted as they are submit to disqualification.
